

## Biography

Alexandra Helmig is a versatile artist working as an actress, author, voice artist and singer. After her A-levels she studied acting in Paris and Hamburg, performed at the Hamburg Kammerspiele and has been in numerous film and TV productions. As a voice artist for various publishing houses she narrates audiobooks and apps and accompanied Margaret Atwood, Elizabeth Gilbert, among others, as their German voice on their reading tours. As an author she writes children's literature, screenplays and theatre plays, with which she was invited to numerous festivals and for which she has won the advancement award of the German "Landesbühnen" in 2008.

In 2017, her screenplay "FRAU MUTTER TIER (MOTHER BEE)" was made into a movie starring Julia Jentsch and other well-known movie and theatre actors and which will be released nationwide in cinemas on August 9th, 2018. She plays one of the lead roles and has written the song "Unspoken" for the soundtrack. "One thing Alexandra Helmig is not lacking is creativity. It is the only explanation for her many artistic professions", MADAME magazine writes. "And she can sing too, as a trained jazz singer with the stage name **Ada Morghe**".

In 2011 she has founded the non-profit **Kinderkunsthhaus Munich**.
